The Lincoln County UW-Extension 4-H Youth Development program is pleased to offer your child(ren) the opportunity to participate in a 4-H after school club during Tomahawk Kinship's Kins Klub. Yvette Chieves, 4-H After School Club Coordinator, will be serving as the leader for this club. The club's first meeting will be held on September 20th from 4:00 – 5:00 p.m. During the monthly meetings, youth will conduct a short business meeting and then participate in a 4-H project activity. The club meeting dates for the rest of the 4-H year are October 25th, November 29th, December 27th, January 24th, February 28th, March 28th, April 25th, May 23rd (summer meeting dates to be set). If any changes to the schedule are made we will announce the changes at the meeting prior.

If your child(ren) are unable to join this After School Club or interested in joining a community 4-H club, we have several community 4-H Clubs located throughout Lincoln County. Please contact us at the UW-Extension office at 715-539-1072 and we will be happy to assist you in locating a community club for your child(ren).

As a member of the 4-H After School Club, your child will receive the 4-H newsletter, Lincoln County 4-H Express. This newsletter is our main form of communication with every family in the 4-H program. It is filled with important information about upcoming events and opportunities that 4-H members and their families may be interested in. You will be receiving the 4-H Express every two months.
