Lincoln County Fair judging will begin with the Junior Dog Show at 8 a.m. Saturday, July 11.

On Saturday, July 18, the Junior Horse Show will be held.

On Wednesday July 22, fair exhibitors in both Junior and Open divisions will present their entries

with judging occurring in many Junior Division departments from noon to 7 p.m. Judging continues that evening in the Junior Cloverbuds and both the Junior and Open Division Flowers and Houseplants departments.

On Thursday, July 23, judging will take place in Junior Beef, Sheep and Swine; Junior and Open Photography; Junior and Open Family Living; Junior and Open Cultural Arts; Open Antiques; Junior and Open Plant and Soil Sciences; and Junior and Open Rabbits.

On Friday, July 24,

judging will take place in the Junior and Open Poultry and Junior Dairy departments.

Judging will conclude on Saturday, July 25, with the Junior Small Animal; Junior Cats; Junior and Open Exotic Animals; and Junior and Open Goats.
