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**Wool Needle Felting**..... Your cost: \$2.50

Learn how to transform wool into 3D objects using a barbed needle. When you felt wool, you're agitating the fibers so they bond together, creating a solid fabric. Come and learn this fun and simple art technique.

**Make a “Gnome” of Your Own** ..... Your cost: \$0.75

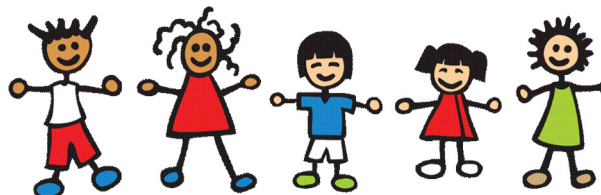
